Will enhanced electrification boost Congo's non-oil GDP growth?

The macro-fiscal returns of enhanced electrification are well documented. A recent International Monetary Fund staff report suggests that each percentage point increase in reliable electricity access could add 0.15 percentage points to Congo's non-oil GDP growth(IMF Article IV Consultation,2024).
