How do I Reset my WAP to factory default settings?

There are two ways to reset the WAP to factory default settings: Step 1. Press the Reset button for more than 10 seconds until the lights go off. Step 2. Release the Reset button when the lights turn back on. Step 1. Log in to the web-based utility of your WAP and choose Administration > Reboot. Step 2. Click the Reboot To Factory Default button.

How do I Hard Reset my AP?

Method 1 is applicable for most of the AP models. For models such as range extenders, they can be hard reset by using Method 2. Method 1 (Access Points): Press and hold the reset button on the rear panel with a small object for approximately 8 to 10 seconds when the device is powered on. You will see all the LED light turn on then off.

With the Base Station powered on, press and hold the RESET button on the Base Station or the Remote Reset button on the passive PoE adapter for about 8 seconds until the Wireless ...

A reset is recommended if most of the WAP settings need to be reconfigured. This article aims to show you how to reboot and reset your WAP to factory default settings.
