What is a Swiss export declaration?

A well-prepared invoice facilitates the customs clearance process and ensures transparency in the transaction. The export declaration, also known as the Single Administrative Document (SAD), is mandatory for any export from Switzerland. It must be submitted via the e-dec Export electronic system of the Swiss Federal Customs Administration.

How do I export goods from Switzerland?

Merchandise that is exported from Switzerland must be declared to Swiss Customs in writing or electronically. An overview of the export procedure is provided below. You can carry out the listed steps yourself or, if necessary, appoint a service provider (haulage firm, courier company, customs clearance agency) for some or all of the procedure.

What documents do you need to export from Switzerland?

Main mandatory documents: commercial invoice, export declaration (e-dec Export), certificate of origin, packing list, and product-specific documents. Essential official links: easy access to forms and procedures from the relevant Swiss authorities. Exporting from Switzerland involves a structured and rigorous process.

Does Switzerland levy customs duties or charges on exportation?

Switzerland does not levy any customs duties or charges upon exportation. However, customs duties or charges may apply in the country of destination - ask the authorities of the country of destination about this. The FOCBS provides the Passar, e-dec web and e-dec Export platforms.
